A part of the final grade is based on the general average of trimestral report cards (11th and 12th grades).

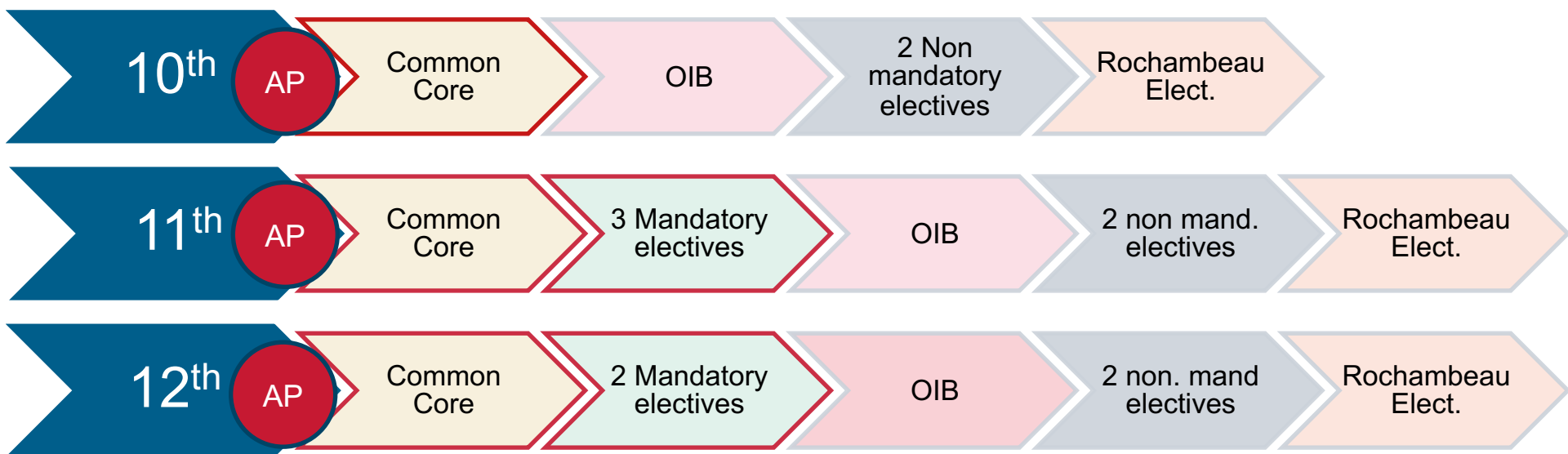
TO BETTER PREPARE STUDENTS FOR COLLEGE ADMISSION

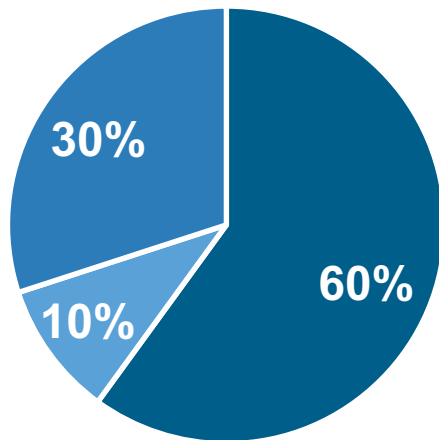

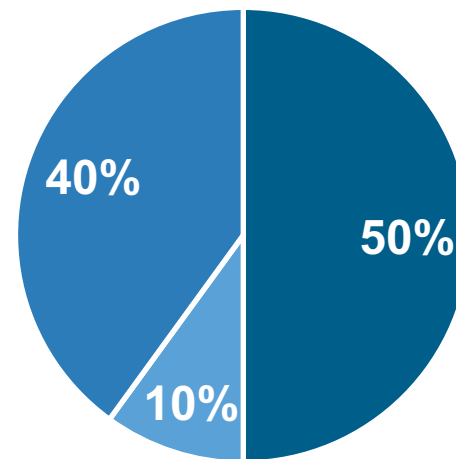
ASSESSMENTS DISTRIBUTION

ASSESSMENT DISTRIBUTION with OIB

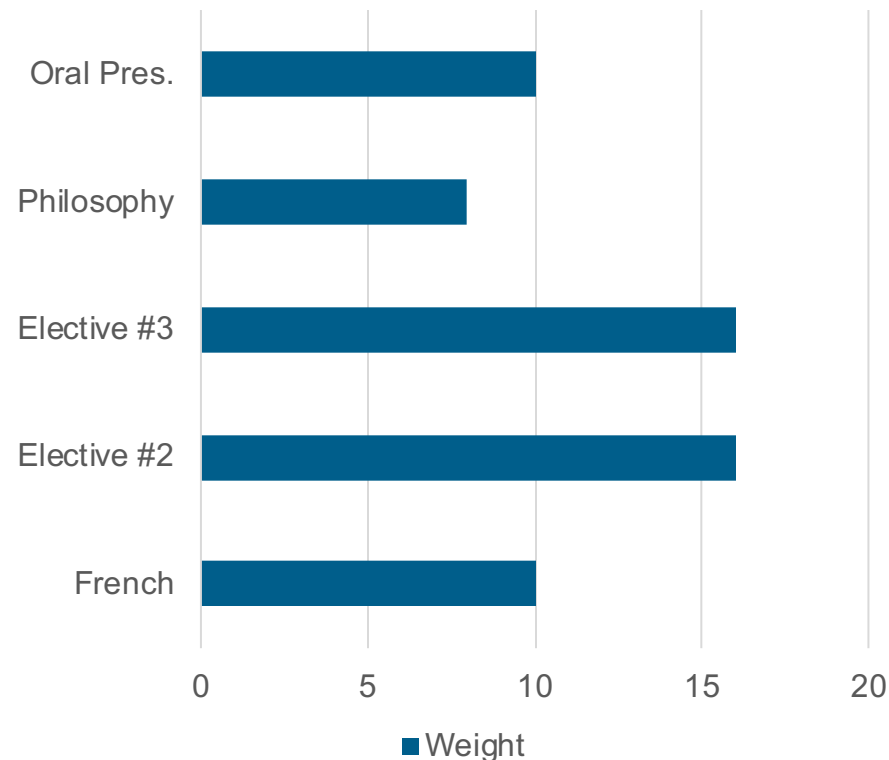

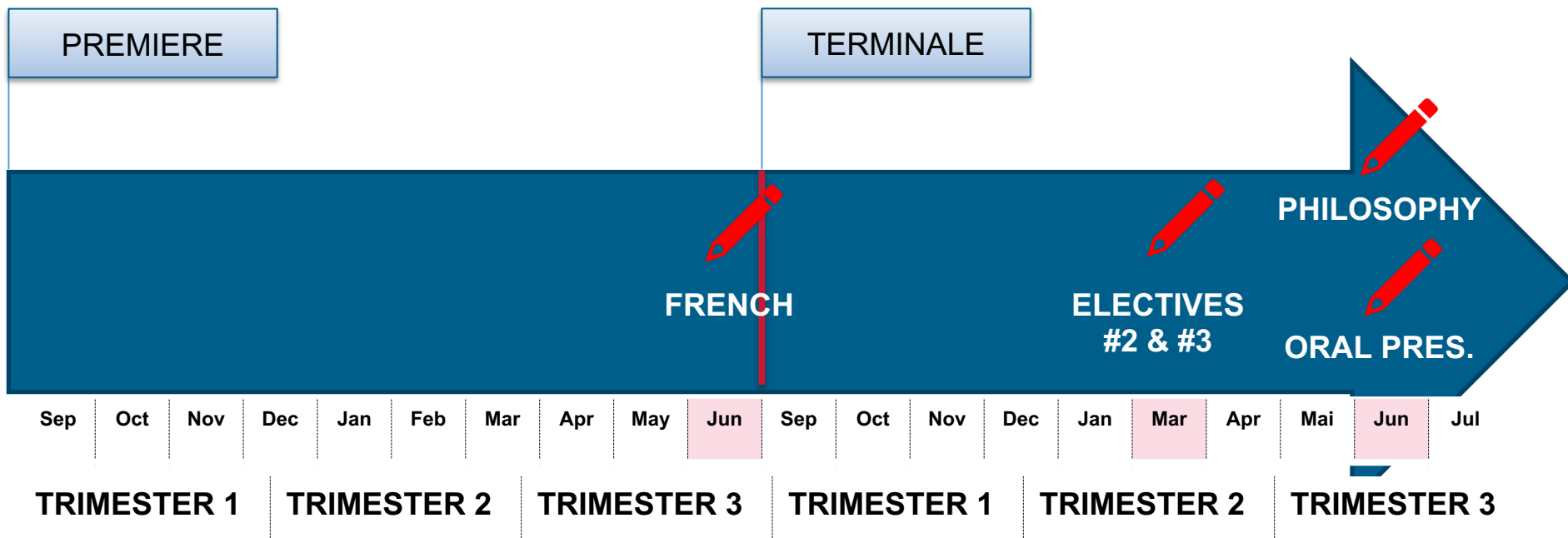

FINAL ASSESSMENT (60% OR 50%)

- **1st Round (11th Grade):** French written and Oral exams (weighted at 5 each)
- **2nd Round (12th grade) : 4 subjects exams :**
 - **Elective #2** (Weighted at 16)
 - **Elective #3** (Weighted at 16)
 - **Philosophy subject test** (Weighted at 8)
 - **Oral Presentation** (Weighted at 10)

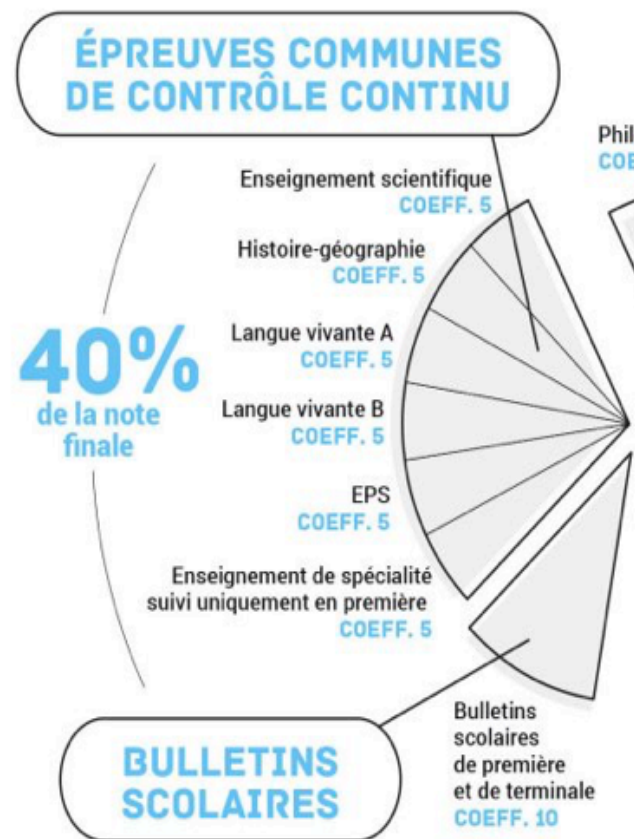
A NEW ASSESSMENT: ORAL PRES.

- The oral presentation is prepared in **11th and 12th grades**. It's a **20 minutes** presentation in front of a jury.
- The presentation is based on the curriculum of the **mandatory electives** selected by the student and based on a **specific project** lead by the student.
- Preparation for the presentation takes place during in 11th and 12th grade, and more specifically **after March of the 12th grade year**, when students are finished with the mandatory elective assessment.

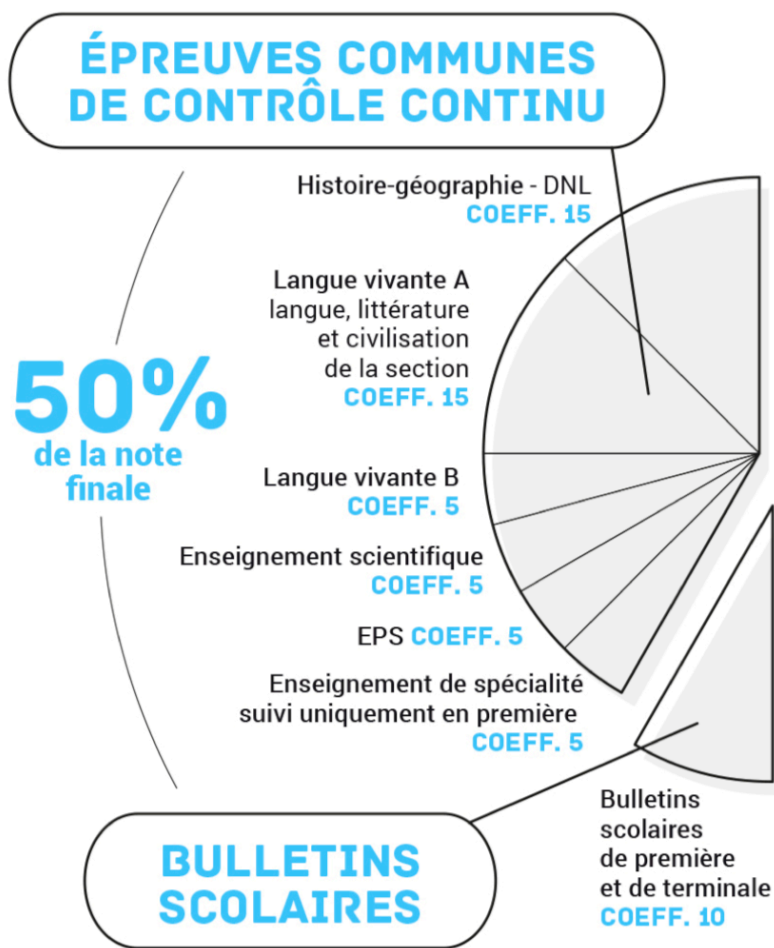
ONGOING ASSESSMENT NON OIB (E3C)

NON OIB ONGOING ASSESSMENT (40%)

- **10 %** based of the general average of 11th and 12th grades report card (weighted at **10**).
- **30 % for the E3C** held in 11th and 12th grades in the following subjects: History-Geography, English, language B (Espagnol, German...), Sciences, Elective# 1, P.E (each Weighted at 5)



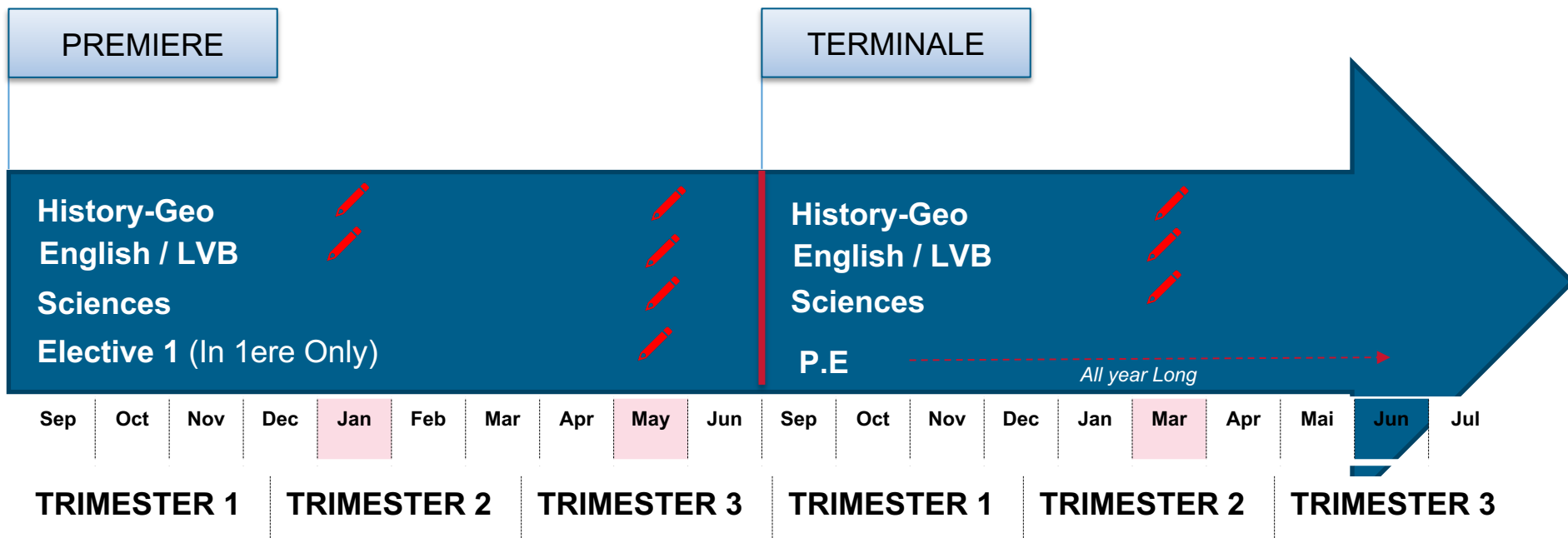
ONGOING ASSESSMENT OIB (E3C)



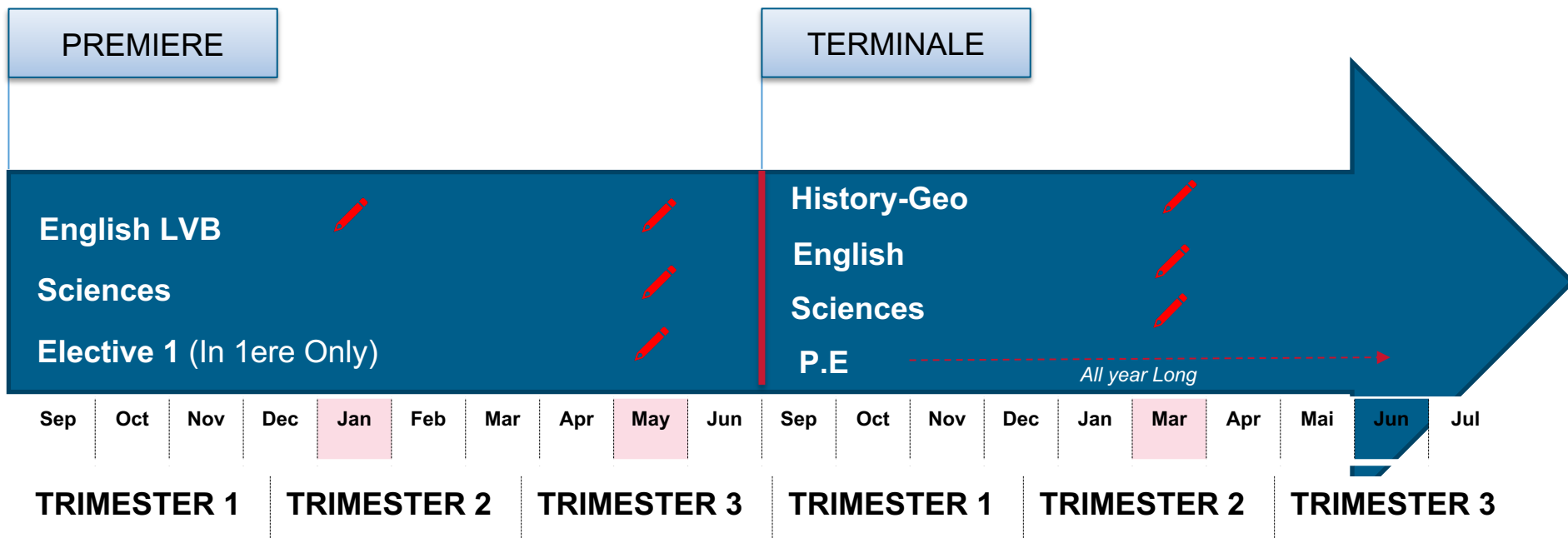
OIB ONGOING ASSESSMENT (50%)

- **10 %** bases of the general average of 11th and 1st grades report card (weighted at **10**).
- **40 % for the E3C** held in 11th and 12th grades in the following subjects: Language B, Sciences, Elective # 1, P.E (each W.@5) **Specific test for English and History-Geography**, Oral and Written (Weighted at 15 each, **THEREFORE 25% of the total grade**

ONGOING ASSESSMENT: CONTENT

- Evaluates subjects that are not tested in final assessment
- Are organized by the school.
 - Tests subjects are selected among a selection of topics provided by the French ministry of education.
 - Copies are anonymous and corrected by teachers other than those of the student.

ON GOING ASSESSMENT AND REPORT CARDS

THE 10% is calculated in two parts:

- The general grade average of the 11th grade class. This grade is weighted at 5 for each subject.
- The general grade average of the 12th grade class. This grade is weighted at 5 for each subject.

To calculate this average, all courses count equally, whether mandatory or optional. Rochambeau Electives are **not taken into account in this average. For Latin (LCA) all points over 10/20 have a weight of 3.**

The grade obtained during the final assessment tests are not included in the calculation of this average.

BACCALAUREAT RETAKE

- Students with a score of 8 or higher **BUT** less than 10 out of 20 are eligible to retake **2 exams**.
- It consists of two oral examinations based on the curriculum of the **common core and/or the mandatory electives**.
- Only grades superior to the ones awarded previously are taken into account in the recount of the baccalaureate.
